PANEL MEETING

WHAT GOES ON DURING THE PANEL MEETING?

- Applications are reviewed following the pre-established Order of Review. Applications are grouped together based on topic and (when relevant) research goal.
- For each application:
 - Reviewers with conflicts of interest leave the room
 - The primary reviewers present their comments and initial scores
 - The full panel discusses the application; an assigned panel member synthesizes the discussion
 - The full panel approves the synthesis
 - The primary reviewers revisit their scores publicly
 - All reviewers score the application privately

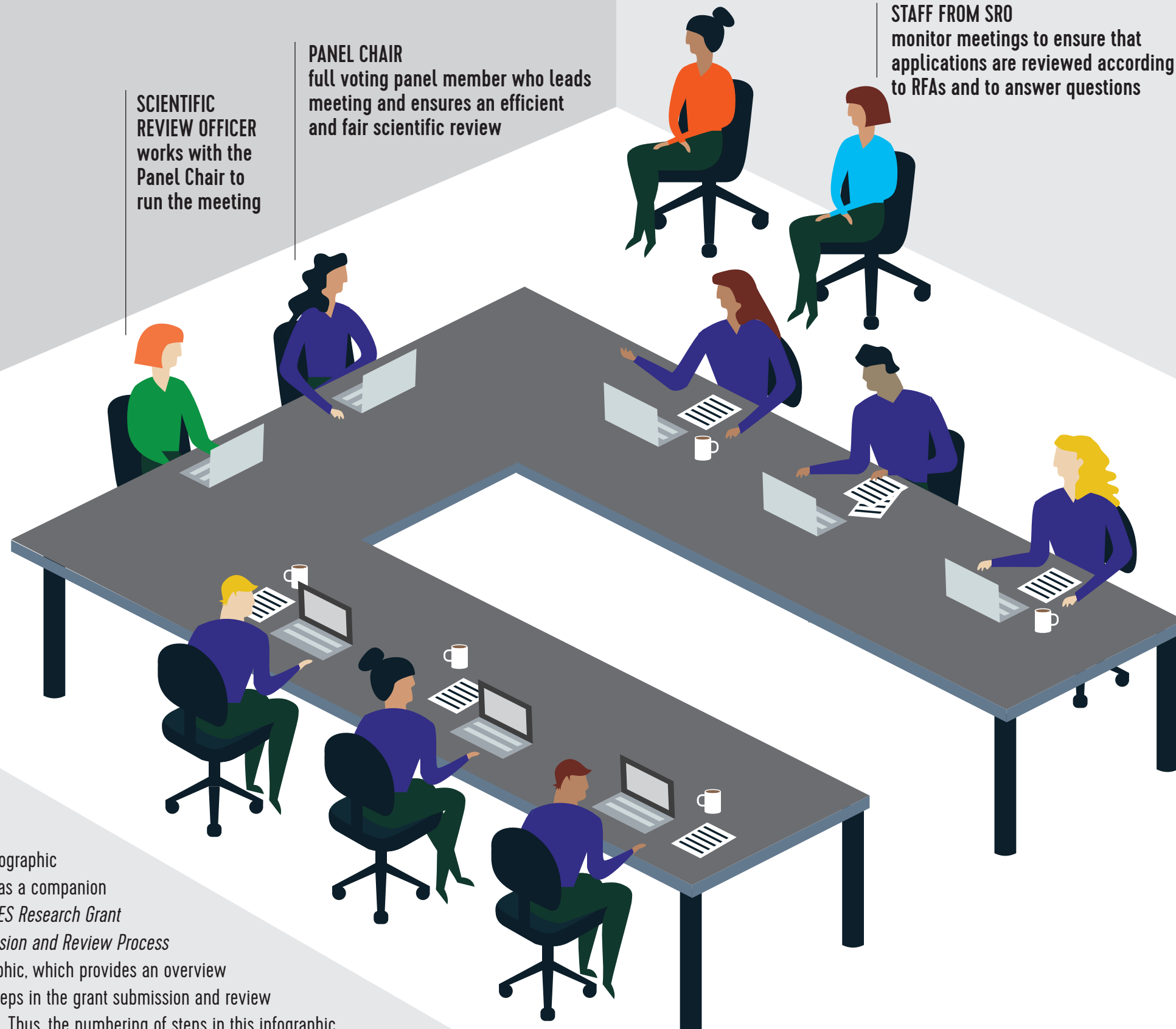
PEER REVIEWERS

STAFF FROM RESEARCH CENTERS observe to provide technical assistance to applicants in the future

STAFF FROM SRO monitor meetings to ensure that applications are reviewed according to RFAs and to answer questions

PANEL CHAIR full voting panel member who leads meeting and ensures an efficient and fair scientific review

SCIENTIFIC REVIEW OFFICER works with the Panel Chair to run the meeting
