Andrew Carnegie Fellows Program

The Carnegie Corporation of New York has issued a request for nominations for the highly prestigious <u>Andrew Carnegie Fellows Program</u>, which provides awards of \$200,000 for a one- or two-year period. The Corporation expects fellows "will explore the ways political polarization in the United States manifests itself in society and provide possible means to alleviate the problems." The UO may nominate one junior scholar and one senior scholar (tenured faculty) for this award. Nominees must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. Interested candidates should submit a <u>preproposal</u> for internal review by **September 10, 2024** to be considered for nomination. The external deadline for the program is **November 8, 2024**.
