APA Dissertation Award

The <u>American Psychological Association's APA Dissertation Research Award</u> offers three grants of \$10,000 and seven grants of \$5,000 to students whose dissertation research reflects excellence in scientific psychology. As a <u>limited submission</u> opportunity, the funder allows each department to endorse only three students per year for this award. Students interested in this opportunity should submit a <u>notice of intent to submit</u> by **October 15, 2024**. The funder's application deadline is **January 30, 2025**.

National Science Foundation Request for Information on Research Ethics

The National Science Foundation has issued this <u>Request for Information</u> to seek input to inform the development of the agency's response to Research Ethics in the CHIPS and Science Act of 2022. Interested individuals and parties are invited to submit <u>responses</u> before 5 p.m. Eastern time on **November 15, 2024**.

Andrew Carnegie Fellows Program - Junior Scholars Internal Deadline Extended

The Carnegie Corporation of New York has issued a request for nominations for the highly prestigious Andrew Carnegie Fellows Program, which provides awards of \$200,000 for a one- or two-year period. The Corporation expects fellows "will explore the ways political polarization in the United States manifests itself in society and provide possible means to alleviate the problems." Nominees must be U.S. citizens or permanent residents. The UO may nominate one junior scholar for this award. Interested junior faculty should submit a preproposal by the extended deadline of **September 23**, **2024** to be considered for nomination.
