Blavatnik National Awards

The UO has been invited to nominate up to three early-career faculty for the <u>Blavatnik Awards for Young Scientists</u> (one per discipline: Chemical Sciences, Life Sciences, and Physical Sciences & Engineering). Eligible nominees must be born in or after 1983 and hold a tenured or tenure-track position. If you are interested in being nominated for this award, please reach out to your department head by **October 8, 2024**. The Blavatnik nomination deadline is December 4, 2024, with letters of support due by December 18, 2024.

Camille Dreyfus Teacher-Scholar Award

The <u>Camille Dreyfus Teacher-Scholar Award</u> is awarded by the Camille and Henry Dreyfus Foundation to early career faculty in the chemical sciences with outstanding contributions to both research and teaching. This is a <u>limited submission</u> opportunity, with the UO allowed to nominate only one tenure-track faculty member each year. Faculty interested in this opportunity should notify the <u>head</u> of the Department of Chemistry and Biochemistry by **November 1, 2024**. The selected faculty member will work with <u>Foundation Relations</u> to submit an application by the deadline of January 30, 2025.
