Medical Research Foundation Merit Awards for Oregon Faculty

The [Medical Research Foundation \(MRF\)](#) provides grants in support of biomedical research performed by faculty in Oregon. The foundation also offers [merit awards](#) to faculty in three categories. Discover Awards recognize faculty who have made significant, original discoveries to health-related research. Mentor Awards recognize faculty who has provided outstanding mentorship and leadership in the support of health research, education or the advancement of health care. The Richard T. Jones New Investigator Awards recognizes a new investigator who shows exceptional promise early in a career in biomedical research. The deadline for nominations is **January 31, 2025**. The Limited Submission Process at the UO

This is a friendly reminder to the UO research community about the limited submission process. Limited submissions occur when the funding agency restricts the number of applications allowed by a single institution. All applicants to limited submission opportunities must fill out a [notice of intent to submit form](#). If there are more interested applicants than allowed, the Office of the Vice President for Research and Innovation (OVPRI) runs a review of preproposals to select the best candidates to move forward with application development. Special guidance describes the process when an interested applicant comes to OVPRI within six weeks or less of the funder deadline.
